What is SAASMC

SAASMC is part of **SASA** (South Atlantic Shrine Association) and **SAASMC** is part of the association which is all motorized units (motorcycles, mini-cars, dune buggies, golf carts etc.) in SASA. **SAASMC** stands for South Atlantic Association of Shrine Motor Corps and the association was started in 1975. There are at present 20 temples who are members of **SAASMC** and we (motor corps units) have 2 meetings per year: The first in March or April and is for MEN ONLY and a fun weekend and usually held in the area of the present motor corps president or where every he chooses. There is lots of food and drink for the members. Reservations **MUST** be made prior so that we know who will be there. You will need to join the association and have a current dues card to attend. The second meeting that we have includes families in September when the mother association (SASA) meets (usually somewhere along the Atlantic coast ,presently in Myrtle Beach) and the member motorized units get together and compete against units in their classification for trophies on Friday morning. This is precision riding (no racing) and obstacle course and is held on a field 150' wide and 300' long with 4 judges and a military type inspection before the unit competes for points to win. We have an Awards Presentation and present our Awards on Friday night. I hope this has answered some of your questions and I would be glad to talk to you on the phone if necessary. I am presently the secretary and have been for several years and a past president of the association. Reservations have to be made in advance for our midwinter.
